Comment on strengths and weaknesses of the instructor	Professor Dinterman was very good at relating to the students in the class. 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Comment on strengths and weaknesses of the instructor	Dinterman seems just as uninterested in teaching the subject as most students are in learning it. That's the feeling I got 75% of the time. He is quite reasonable and respectful as a professor, but his lectures are hardly worth attending. His notes are barely helpful and only vaguely reflect on the material that is covered on exams, although he does passively assign readings from the text, this is where all information is located. Why then have a professor? Just schedule tests every 3 or 4 weeks and expect students to have read the required chapters, the results will be the same, and it allows for Mr. Dinterman to use his own time more effectively.
